

Eugene Friends Meeting
Lane County Low Risk COVID-19
Health Monitor Protocol

Preamble:

Welcome! During the COVID-19 pandemic, Eugene Friends Meeting chooses to safeguard the health of individuals in our Meeting and our wider community. We do so by seeking guidance from our Spirit-led Light Within and by following local, state and national Public Health authorities' recommendations.

Protocol:

The Meeting House will be set up prior to the event, cleaned and sanitized after each event to minimize risk of exposure to the COVID-19 virus for all participants. All participants will affirm that they are at Low Risk of contagion to others and agree to participate based on their affirmation. Participants will engage in hand hygiene, physical distancing and wear appropriate face coverings upon entry and until exiting the building. Room occupancy maximums are posted and should not be exceeded.

Health Monitor:

The Health Monitor is an accountable, empowered individual who implements this protocol. Every event within our Meeting House and upon our grounds will have a Health Monitor whose duties are to manage set-up and clean-up procedures and ensure that each participant:

- Acknowledges the entry affirmation signage
- Has a face covering
- Has access to hand hygiene
- Follows the physical distancing cues

Process:

Facility set-up, break down and sanitizing:

1. The Health Monitor sets-up and cleans-up after the event, is the first to arrive and the last to leave.
2. The Health Monitor:
 - a. Arrives at least 30 minutes prior to convening
 - i. Create/check physical distancing cues
 - ii. Arrange spacing of seating (benches/chairs)
 - iii. Tape benches and/or floors to mark off appropriate distancing (6 feet of separation)
 - iv. Ensure accessibility of proper handwashing and/or sanitizing
 - v. Provide Set-up, Preparation, and Sanitizing Check Lists
 - b. Upon participate entry and during the event
 - i. Communicate and enforce that no singing/food eating is allowed
 - ii. Reinforce and teach the use of face coverings
 - iii. Control movements
 - iv. Encourage outdoor post-event socializing
 - c. After the event:
 - i. Clean and sanitize space used
 - ii. Assure all doors and windows are closed and secure
 - iii. Set air purifiers on HIGH and to set timer to turn off in one hour

Children's Meeting Addendum:

Follow all protocols EXCEPT:

The wearing of face coverings on children under the age of 2 is not recommended. Face coverings cannot be required for the use of children and should never prohibit or prevent access to activities.

Group size is a maximum of 12: 10 children and 2 adults, one of which is the Health Monitor.
