Electrify Eugene Campaign: From 350 - "We have a strategy plan from February to June (five months) 2022 to build support for starting the electrification of all new buildings in Eugene in January 2023. Each month we're organizing an escalating campaign with varied tactics to build community awareness and win the local policy we need to cut our greenhouse gas emissions. We're planning wall murals, postcard campaigns, newspaper & radio ads, EV parades, as well as Letters to the Editor. We're building our teams now.

We're currently recruiting new and past LTE writers. We'll provide the talking points, schedule and guidelines for submissions, as well as editorial support. Reduction Carbon **Footprint Project:** While we strive to reduce our consumption of gasoline in cars, the amount we fly in airplanes, and the plastic we use, it is all but impossible to totally eliminate fossil fuel consumption. Eugene Friends Meeting established The Carbon Footprint Reduction Fund in 2016, which grows through a voluntary carbon tax. The fund is then invested in climate change related activities. To date the only expenditure from the fund has been a contribution towards the solar panel project on the Meetinghouse. The fund has been dormant for over a year, but there is interest in reviving it. The Peace and Justice Committee requests:

- a) that you consider calculating your carbon footprint, using tools available on the internet like: Take Action Carbon Footprint Calculator;
- b) consider making donations to the EFM Carbon Footprint Reduction Fund based on the calculated cost of your carbon footprint;
- c) offer suggestions to the Peace and Justice Committee on how the Carbon Tax Fund can best be invested.
